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MENTAL HEALTH CLINICIAN POSITION AT IMCES

Advanced Graduate-level Employment and Training Opportunity

Description / Opportunity:

The world turns to recognize mental health challenges as an inevitable pandemic of our time.

IMCES as a community clinic is prepared and committed to responding to the evolving and ever changing needs of our communities. IMCES also recognizes the communities' need for effective workforce development of emerging professionals in the health and mental health disciplines. The aim of this advanced graduate-level program is to provide professional training and service delivery opportunity in two major areas: **prevention and early intervention (PEI)** and **severe mental illness (SMI)**. The program includes a variety of didactic seminars, including Law & Ethics and Cultural Diversity & Advocacy, as well as action oriented research and evaluation. The target client population includes the full spectrum from low to high intensity level of care, of different age groups, from culturally and linguistically diverse communities. The structure of the program includes practicing as a member of a collaborative multidisciplinary care team, inclusive of attorney as case manager, substance abuse specialist, psychiatrist/psychiatric mental health nurse practitioner, and other mental health professionals.

Purpose of the Program:

The overarching goal of this program is to provide the highest standard of service delivery to individuals and families with their complex mental health challenges in our communities, while providing the highest level of professional development opportunity.

Candidates Must Meet the Following Qualifications and Eligibility Requirements:

- Master's or Doctoral degree from an accredited college or university in psychology or relevant discipline with waiver/registered with relevant board (BOP or BBS).
- Successful completion of **two years** clinical experience.
 - (Compensation will be adjusted for individuals with less than two years after degree.)

Mental Health Clinicians are provided with supervised professional experience (SPE) hours, as required for licensing in the State of California.

Compensation:

\$50,000 for clinician with Master's degree
\$60,000 for clinician with PhD or PsyD degrees
Including travel expense and cultural incentive
and based on **2 years prior clinical experience.**

Benefits:

- IMCES holidays: 10 days
- Personal and Professional Time Off (PTO): 20 days
- Comprehensive Health Insurance

Application Process:

This program is ongoing with open enrollment throughout the year.

To be considered, submit the following:

- Letter of intent clearly indicating why you would be a right match for the position
- Two letters of recommendation from direct clinical supervisors
- **Official transcript** for verification of degree **and diploma**
- **Official verification of years of clinical experience**
- Successful outcome of interview to determine goodness of fit
